RECOMMENDATIONS

DIPTEREX 80% Soluble Powder is recommended for control of flies, houseflies, crickets, silverfish, and bedbugs in and around the home and other structures, restaurants, hotels, stores, warehouses, and in the immediate vicinity of food processing plants.

DOSAGE: Mix contents of packet (50 grams) in 1 gallon of water. Application should be made to be treated by spraying to the point of run-off, except where otherwise indicated. A fresh solution should be prepared daily. Agitate solution thoroughly before using.

FOR CONTROL OF ROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH:

Applications should be made with a coarse spray, or with a paint brush, to baseboards, cracks, crevices, and other insect hiding places. Also apply to adjacent exterior surfaces where the insects will crawl when they come out of hiding. Repeat as necessary to maintain effective control. Protect food and water.

FOR BEDBUG CONTROL:

In addition to treating baseboards and cracks and crevices, treat head, including a light application to tufts and seams of mattresses. Under no circumstances should mattresses be soaked with spray. Treated mattresses should be aired until dry (for at least 6 hours) before reuse. Treatment of infant bedding, including the crib, should be avoided.

FOR CONTROL OF DOG AND CAT FLIES:

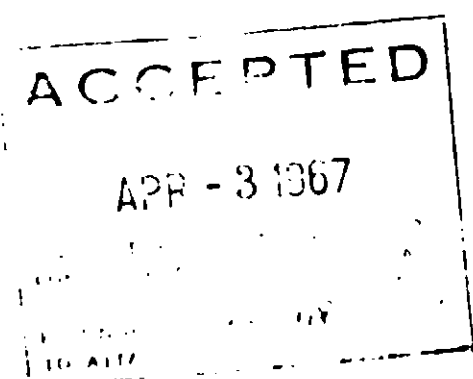
Apply 1 gallon of spray solution per 1,000 square feet (30 X 20 feet) of yard area. Also treat dog or cat sleeping quarters, kennels, and other areas frequented by animals. Remove animals before treating. Allow spray deposit to dry before admitting animal. Repeat as necessary to maintain effective control.

FOR FLY CONTROL IN AND AROUND RESTAURANTS, HOTELS, KITCHENS, AND BOWLING ALLEYS, AND OUTSIDE SPACES:

Apply as a coarse spray, or with a paint brush, to selected surfaces, such as doors, screens, window frames, and other areas where flies will be or congregate. Apply only when animals and humans are absent. Also apply to garbage areas and other places where refuse has collected. Use 1 quart of spray solution per 100 square feet of manure piles and garbage dumps. Repeat applications every 1 to 2 weeks or as fly populations warrant. For longer residual control, add 1 pound of sugar to each gallon of DIPTEREX solution. DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER OR FOOD. Good sanitation, including prompt disposal of waste, will aid in delaying re-infection.

RESTRICTIONS

Do not apply directly to animals. Do not spray kennels or other animal areas unless animals have been removed. Allow spray deposits to dry before animals are re-admitted. Do not contaminate food, water, or food processing equipment. Do not treat manure waste which may be fed to livestock.



WARNING
