HOW TO USE: BAYGON Household Insect Spray is ready to use undiluted as it comes from the can, and may be applied with either power-operated or hand sprayers. Apply as a coarse spray to infected surfaces until wet, moving the spray stream rapidly enough to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces and waste of material. Direct spray away from people, plants, and pets.

RESTRICTIONS: Do not apply to rugs, carpets, draperies, wallpaper, or similar materials that may be stained. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt surfaces such as tiles and floor coverings. Do not allow the small, finger-operated, plastic attachment type sprayer to remain in BAYGON Insect Spray solution for extended periods as the plastic sprayer may be damaged.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

INDOOR USE:  
ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES (EXPOSED STAGE), WATERBUGS: Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. Repeat as needed. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Do not allow children to contact treated areas until surfaces are thoroughly dry.

~~ANTS~~ BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not spray animals

OUTDOOR USE:  
ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, MILLIPEDES, SOWBUGS, AND BROWN DOG TICKS  
~~ANTS~~: Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects may enter. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation

BED BUGS: In addition to treating baseboards and cracks and crevices, treat beds, including a light application to tufts and seams of mattresses. Under no circumstances should mattresses be soaked with spray. Treated mattresses should be aired until dry (for at least 8 hours) before re-use. Treatment of infant bedding, including the crib, should be avoided.

WARNING
