Walnuts	Aphids Codling moth European red mite Filbertworm <u>Navel orangeworm</u>	3/4 to 1 7/8	Apply specified dosage in 100 gallons of water as a full coverage spray* using not more than 1100 gallons of finished spray per acre. Repeat as necessary. Do not apply after husks split. Do not graze livestock in treated groves for 21 days after treatment.

*This concentration is calculated for conventional hydraulic-type sprayers. When lower volumes of spray are applied per acre with concentrate sprayers, increase the concentration of GUTHION in the spray mixture in order to apply amount of GUTHION per acre equivalent to a full coverage spray.
