CONDITIONS OF SALE: These Directions for Use reflect the opinion of experts based on tests of effectiveness, of toxicity to laboratory animals and of residues on or in food and feed under normal conditions of use. However, because of the wide range of conditions under which this product may be used, even though label directions are followed, it is impossible to eliminate all risks associated with its use because of abnormal conditions beyond the control of the seller. Chemagro Corporation and the Seller offer, and the Buyer uses, this product subject to the understanding that the Buyer assumes all such risks.

Louse and Horn Tly Control:

Suspend CO-RAL Duster in areas frequented by cattle or in gateways or lanes through which the animals pass daily for water, feed or mineral. Bags may also be suspended in loafing sheds or in front of protected mineral feeders. For lactating dairy cows, CO-RAL Ter may be suspended in the exit through which cows leave the milking barn. In all cases, the bags should be adjusted so that the bottom of the bag will hang four to six inches below the topline of the cattle.

Louse and Horn Fly Control and as an Aid in Reducing Face Fly Populations:

Suspend CO-RAL Duster in the same manner as described under "Louse and Horn Fly Control" except as follows: (1) The bottom of the bags should be 18 to 24 inches from the ground to insure that the faces of the cattle will be dusted. (2) The bags must be located so the animals will be forced to use them daily.

INSTALLATION OF CO-RAL DUSTER:

Suspend the bags by inserting rope, chain, or wire through the promets at the top of the bag and attaching to an overhead structure or by hooking the promets into hooks fixed to a stationary overhead 2 x 4 at the heights recommended for louse and horn fly or face fly control. In areas of frequent or heavy rainfall, CO-RAL Dusters all be protected from the weather.

Install as many 10-pound CO-RAL Dusters as necessary in lanes or other openings to assure proper dusting of the animals. After the bags are in place, pull the rip cord to allow the insecticide to fall into the bottom of the bag.
