MAYLUSCIDE - TFM active ingredient has proved to be an excellent treatment for control of the mosquito larvae (*Culex quinquefasciatus*) in tributaries flowing into the Great Lakes.

For best results, treatment should first be bioassayed to determine the minimum concentration of MAYLUSCIDE - TFM that will be required to kill larval larvae. The concentration required varies depending upon water hardness and temperature. In addition, it is necessary to conduct a pre-treatment bioassay to determine the maximum concentration that can be applied without causing fish mortality. Calculate the desired dilution and add the proper amount of MAYLUSCIDE - TFM required to give a final concentration in the range between the minimum concentration required to kill mosquito larvae and the maximum concentration that can be applied without causing fish toxicity.

DANGER
