Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system, and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema, which may develop in serious cases of poisoning ever after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.
