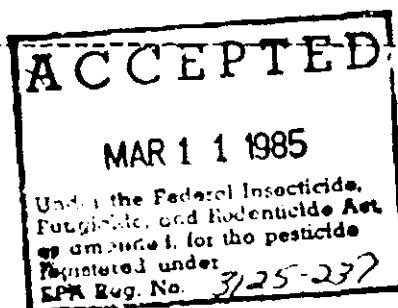

AMENDMENT TO PREVIOUSLY REGISTERED LABELING

Revise to Read as Follows:

RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS

USE	PEST	DOSAGE-NEMACUR 10% TURF & ORNAMENTAL	REMARKS
Anthurium	Nematodes	19 to 39 ozs. per 1000 square feet or 51 to 105 lbs. per acre	Apply specified dosage uniformly to the area. Irrigate immediately after treatment using a minimum of 1/2 inch of water. Do not apply more than twice in any one 12 month period.
Iris, Lily and Narcissus bulbs	Nematodes	60 to 120 lbs. per acre (based on 42 inch rows - 12,445 linear feet of row per acre) or 4 3/4 to 9 1/2 lbs per 1000 feet of row	Apply specified dosage in the furrow at time of planting so that the material is incorporated into the covering soil, or in a 10 to 12 inch band over the row after planting. NOTE: On year old plantings, apply over the row. Irrigate immediately after treatment using a minimum of 1/2 inch of water. Tolerance of bulbs to NEMACUR may vary with varieties. Test a small number of plants if tolerance is not locally known. Do not apply to green foliage.
