DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CO-RAL 1% Ready-To-Use Spray requires no further dilution. For beef and dairy cattle, apply with a hand powered spray gun or a low pressure power sprayer delivering a fine mist spray. Direct as a light spray to the back, flanks, neck, withers and lower front legs of the animal. Do not attempt to obtain penetration of the spray to the skin.

Apply to dairy cows after either the morning or evening milking. Avoid treatment of udder area.

Make daily applications using 1 to 2 fluid ounces per head for up to three consecutive days to achieve initial horn fly control. Make repeat treatments using 1 to 2 fluid ounces every 5 to 7 days as required to maintain control. Animals should be retreated after exposure to heavy rainfall.

RESTRICTIONS

Avoid contamination of drinking water, feed trough, milk or milking utensils. Provide thorough ventilation while spraying.

CAUTION

For external insecticidal use on animals. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid prolonged inhalation of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Wash with soap and warm water after handling. Do not contaminate feed, food or drinking water. Keep out of reach of children.

Should poisoning occur, obtain prompt medical aid. Prolonged exposure will result in cholinesterase depression.

TO PHYSICIAN:

Atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container Destroz it by burying with wastes or burning. Stay away from smoke or fumes.
