Your Submissions Dated February 2, 1991

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. In the precautionary statements remove the "causes eye irritation" statement.
- b. The statement of practical statement should read as follows:

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

- c. The directions for use of syrup of ipecac included in the statements of practical treatment ("If vomiting does not

occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer a second dose") must comply with the directions which appear on the ipecac label. The agency will not approve instructions for the use of syrup of ipecac which conflict with those instructions on the ipecac label.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

AMENDMENT  
To Previously Registered Labeling

Revise as Follows:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

CAUTION

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Causes eye irritation. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic skin reactions in some individuals. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing dust or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, vomiting should be induced. Administer water freely and induce vomiting by giving one dose (1/2 oz or 15 mL) of syrup of ipecac. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately.

If on skin, wash skin immediately with soap and water.

If eyes are contaminated, wash with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: The compound does not cause any definite symptoms that would be diagnostic. Poisoning is accompanied by hyperactivity followed by sedation.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: No specific antidote. Treat symptomatically.
