If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by clicking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious patient. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and warm water.

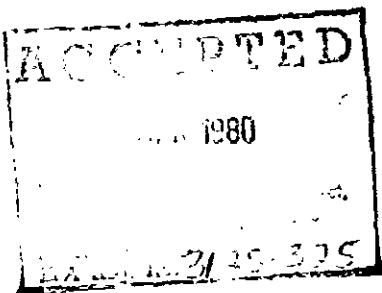

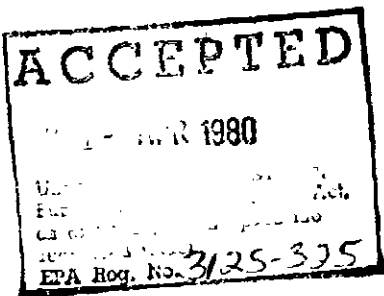
