PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Corrosive. Causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes. Wear goggles or face shield when handling concentrate. May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid exposure. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Do not breathe vapors. Do not contaminate feed or food. Keep out of reach of children. Always wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If splashed in eyes, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For further treatment, get medical attention.

In case of contact, wash with soap and water. In case of poisoning, call a physician immediately. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

If swallowed vomiting should be induced. Administer water freely and induce vomiting by giving one dose (1/2 oz. or 15 ml.) of syrup of ipecac. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use, pour, spill, or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR REPACKAGING

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This pesticide may be used only for repackaging of an insecticide. No changes may be made in formulation either by dilution or addition of other ingredients.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Disposal (Except Household): Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

Handle and open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If container is leaking invert to prevent leakage. If the container is leaking or material spilled for any reason or cause, carefully dam up spilled material to prevent runoff. Refer to Precautionary Statements on label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. Do not walk through spilled material. Absorb spilled material with absorbing type compounds and dispose of as directed for pesticides above. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away.
