To Previously Registered Labeling

Move Hyperodes weevil to the soil insect section as follows:

Sod webworm

Chinch bugs

larvae

Apply 1 1b. 14 ozs. or 3 2/3 1bs. per 1000 sq. ft., (use higher rate for severe infestations) when insect damage is first observed. Apply 1/4 to 1/2 inch of water immediately after treatment. Re-apply as necessary for pest re-infestation (see restrictions)

Hyperodes weevil

For Hyperodes weevil control: Apply in the Spring between full bloom periods of forsythia and flowering dogwood, usually April 15 to May 15 and water-in as directed above.

Fire ants

Area Fire Ant Control: Apply 3 2/3 lb. per 1000 sq. ft. uniformly over area to be treated for residual control. Water immediately after application using 1/2 to 1 inch of water. If established fire ant mounds are present treat the mounds with a drench treatment using an EPA accepted product prior to area application. If a mound drench treatment is made with a product containing OFTANOL isofenphos, then only one area treatment may be made with this product.
