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

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HAZARDS TO HUMANS



Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Rapidly absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not inhale. Do not take internally. Wear a mask or respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. SYMPTOMS OF POISONING

A sense of "tightness" in the chest, sweating, contracted pupils, stomach pain, vomiting and diarrhea.

In case of poisoning call a physician immediately. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

If swallowed, vomiting should be induced. Administer water freely and induce vomiting by giving one dose (1/2 oz. or '5 ml.) of syrup of ipecac. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have patient lie down and keep quiet. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately.

If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably month to mouth. Get medical assistance immediately.

<u>f on skin</u>, in case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash with soap and water. If irritation occurs, get medical attention.

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If eyes are contaminated, wash with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

TO PHYSICIAN:

Antidote - Atropine is antidotal. Administer atropine sulfate in large, therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of tolerance. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of central nervous system and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema which may develop in serious cases of poisoning even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to birds and other wildlife. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters except in accordance with a NPDES permit. For further guidance, contact the nearest EPA Regional Office.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
