To Previously Registered Labeling

Substitute the Following for the Current Almond Recommended Application

RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS

CROP	INSECT	Pounds GUTHION 35% WP	REMARKS
Almonds	Navel Orangeworm Peach twig borer	4 1/4 to 5 11/16	Apply specified dosage per acre by concentrate sprayer or as a full coverage spray using not more than 400 gallons of finished spray per acre. If conditions dictate an aerial spray, apply specified dosage by aircraft in not less than 20 gallons of water per acre. Application is limited to one dormant spray and/or two post-bloom sprays per season. Last application may be made up to 28 days before harvest. Allow at least 120 days between the dormant and the first post-bloom spray and at least 28 days between the post-bloom sprays. Do not graze livestock in treated groves for 21 days after treatment.
