

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid inhalation of vapors and contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving, or storage areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pill Bugs, Crickets.

Cover exposed food, dishes, and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press the valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick and flea control product prior to re-entry.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

THIS PRODUCT HAS BEEN TESTED FOR A RANGE OF WEATHER CONDITIONS SIMILAR TO THOSE WEATHER CONDITIONS THAT ARE ORDINARY AND CUSTOMARY IN THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA WHERE THE PRODUCT IS USED. MESUROI 2% Bait is very effective for the control of slugs, snails and sowbugs; and to aid in control of millipedes around the home and in flower gardens. The bait should be broadcast over plant foliage (except California) or applied to soil around plants.

CAUTION: Do not use around food crops.

Sprinkle 1 pound of MESUROI 2% Bait uniformly over 1000 square feet of area to be treated. For best results lightly water the area to be treated before applying the bait. When making applications, special attention should be given to treating areas around flower beds, and around building foundations. Repeat applications as necessary to keep areas free of pests.

RESTRICTIONS

Do not use on plants grown for food. Do not put bait in piles. Scatter bait so that it is hardly visible on the ground.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Household: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and put in trash collection.

Pesticide Disposal (Except Household): Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal (Except Household): Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (Continued)

Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

Handle and open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If the container is leaking or material spilled for any reason or cause, carefully sweep material into a pile. Refer to Precautionary Statements on label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. Do not walk through spilled material. Material that cannot be used as directed should be disposed of as directed above. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away. HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing.

Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use. Do not contaminate feed or food. Keep out of reach of children and domestic pets.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: A sense of "tightness" in the chest. Sweating. Contracted pupils. Stomach pains. Vomiting and diarrhea.

In case of poisoning call a physician or Poison Control Center. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

ANTIDOTE - Administer atropine sulfate in large therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of tolerance.

Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system, and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema, which may develop in serious cases of poisoning even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, vomiting should be induced. Administer water freely and induce vomiting by giving one dose (1/2 oz. or 15 ml.) of syrup of ipecac. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately. In case of poisoning, call a physician immediately. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

If on skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin immediately with soap and warm water.

If eyes are contaminated, wash with flowing water for at least 15 minutes.
