TEMPO 20 WP Ornamental Insecticide contains 20% active ingredient which will provide effective knockdown and residual control of the pests listed in this label.

This package contains pre-measured 50 gram [140 gram] water soluble (PVA) packets of TEMPO 20 WP Ornamental Insecticide. Do not allow the inner packets to become wet before adding to the spray tank. Do not handle the clear inner packets of TEMPO 20 WP with wet hands or gloves. Rough handling may cause breakage. Do not store at temperatures below 32° F. Allow packages to warm above 50° F before use. Cooler water temperatures increase the time needed for the inner packet to dissolve completely.

MIXING: The enclosed packets containing TEMPO 20% WP Ornamental Insecticide are water solvible. Do not allow packet to become wet prior to adding to the spray tank. Do not handle with wet hands. Reseal outer carton to protect remaining packets.

To prepare the spray mixture, drop the required number of unopened packets, as determined under use instructions, into the spray tank while filling with water to the desired level. Operate the agitator while mixing. Depending on the water temperature and the degree of agitation, the packets should be completely dissolved within approximately 5 minutes from the time they were added to the water.

TANK MIXING: The user, at his discretion, can tank mix pesticides currently registered for use unless the product labels prohibit such use. It is always recommended that a small jar compatibility test using proper proportions of chemicals and water be run to check for physical compatibility prior to tank mixing.

When used at recommended rates and as directed under RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS, TEMPO 20 WP Ornamental Insecticide will control the designated pests on trees, shrubs, foliage plants and flowers in outdoor landscaped areas such as parks, recreational areas, athletic fields, institutional grounds, etc., and interior plantscapes (such as in hotels, shopping malls, cffice buildings, etc.) where these plants are grown. TEMPO 20 WP Insecticide also controls designated pests on landscape turf, including home lawns, business and office complexes, shopping complexes, multi-family residential complexes, airports, cemeteries, parks, playgrounds and athletic fields, and other landscape turfgrass.

NOTE: Not for use in commercial greenhouses, nurseries, on sodfarms or grass grown for seed. Not for use on golf course turf.

APPLICATION ON ORNAMENTALS: TEMPO 20 WP Ornamental Insecticide mixes readily with water and may be used in all types of spray equipment. Mix product with the required amount of water and apply as a dilute spray application to the point of run-off. When spraying hard-towet foliage such as holly, pine or ivy, the addition of a spreader/sticker may enhance both knock-down and residual activity. If concentrate or mist type spray equipment is used, an equivalent amount of product should be used on the area sprayed, as would be used in a dilute application. When mixing a concentrated solution, additional time may be required to fully dissolve the PVA packet(s). Phytotoxicity testing has been carried out on a wide range of ornamental plants under various environmental conditions and no phytotoxicity has been observed. It is advised to pre-spray a selection of ornamentals if local use expenience is unavailable. Time applications to flowering plants during periods when pollinating insects a e not present, such as early morning or late evening.

APPLICATIONS ON TURF: TEMPO 20 WP Insecticide mixes readily with water and/or various fertilizer solutions and can be used in appropriate spray equipment to treat listed turfgrass. Applications should be made with accurately calibrated equipment and applied uniformly, using a coarse, large droplet, spray applications procedure. Do not allow crift unto ponds, streams, or lakes. For optimum control of armyworms, cutworms and sod webworms, delay irrigation and mowing for at least 24 hours following the application. Keep children and pets off treated areas until grass has dried following application.

COMPATIBILITY: TEMPO 20 WP Ornamental Insecticide has been found to be compatible with all commonly used fungicides, miticides, liquid fertilizers and other insecticides. Check physical compatibility using the correct proportion of products in a small jar if local experience is unavailable.

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.
