### STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**If swallowed:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or, if available, administer 1 tablespoonful (15 mL) of syrup of ipecac followed by 1 to 2 glasses of water. If vomiting does not occur within 20 minutes, repeat the dose once. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on skin:** Wash thoroughly with soap and water. If irritation occurs, get medical attention. **If eyes are contaminated:** wash with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

**If inhaled:** remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention.

**In case of poisoning,** call a physician or Poison Control Center. Have patient lie down and keep quiet. It is also requested that Bayer Corporation, Agriculture Division, Kansas City, Missouri be notified. Telephone number is 800-414-0244.

**To Physician:** No specific antidote is available. Treat the patient symptomatically.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is highly toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. ## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMIDACLOPRID Technical is intended for formulation into end use products for:

**Terrestrial Non-food Crop, or Residential and Commercial Outdoor:** Lawns, turfgrasses, ornamentals;

**Terrestrial Food Crop:** Apple, Potato, Cotton, and edible seed crops for Sorghum.

**Greenhouse Non-food Crop or Residential and Commercial Indoor:** Ornamentals

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
