The Agency is conditionally approving an amendment of the registration of the above-referenced product under the authority of section 3(c)(7)(b) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA). This amendment allows a time limited registration on tobacco, to expire automatically April 10, 1997. In addition, during the period that this amendment is effective, it will be subject to the conditions listed below. To maintain your registration you must:

1. The Agency has received your final completed results of the 5 tobacco crop field trials. This data is pending review, therefore the Agency is granting this conditional registration for one year period in order for the field trial data to be reviewed. However, before we will complete a review of this data you must make this submission one of your priority reviews you wish the Agency to perform. This priority listing can be added to your current list of priorities or can be one of the next listing of priorities of Bayer.
2. You will submit production information (pounds or gallons produced) for this product for the fiscal year in which the use on tobacco is conditionally registered, in accordance with FIFRA section 29. The Fiscal year begins October 1 and ends September 30. The production information will be submitted to the Agency no later than November 15, following the end of the preceding fiscal year.
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

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You should note that if you fail to satisfy the condition imposed on this registration, e.g., you fail to submit the required data by the specified deadline or the data submitted were not generated in accordance with the application test guidelines, EPA may issue a Notice to cancel this amendment under section 6(e) of FIFRA.

You should also note that, regardless of whether you satisfy the conditions, this conditional registration will expire automatically on April 10, 1997.

The Agency will not renew or extend this conditional registration for tobacco until the additional field trials data have been reviewed and accepted.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
