WHAT MERIT 0.2 G LAWN AND GARDEN INSECTICIDE DOES

White grubs can cause extensive damage to turf by feeding on grass roots. Affected turf turns yellow, then brown, and is easily pulled up in pieces with your hands. Mole crickets can seriously damage lawns by their tunneling activity. Some species also feed on the grass roots, as well. MERIT 0.2 G prevents turf damage by killing grubs and mole crickets when they are newly hatched and before they can cause turf damage.

MERIT 0.2 G works best when applied before grubs and mole crickets hatch. The active ingredient will remain in the root zone of the turf until the eggs of grubs or mole crickets hatch. These newly hatched insects are highly susceptible to MERIT, and are killed before they become large enough to cause turf damage. MERIT 0.2 G also kills grubs in landscaped ornamental areas containing flowers, ground covers, shrubs and trees.

If you have questions regarding the best time to make applications in your area, you can consult your local County University Extension Office. Be sure that you describe the product you are using when seeking such advice.

HOW TO APPLY MERIT 0.2 G LAWN AND GARDEN INSECTICIDE

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

APPLICATION TO LAWNS:

<u>Pests Controlled:</u> White grubs (including the larvae of Japanese beetle, Oriental beetle, Chaters, Asiatic garden beetle, May or June beetles, and black turfgrass ataenius) and mole crickets.

How to Apply: Using either a drop-type or rotary-type spreader, apply MERIT 0.2 G uniformly over the area being treated. Avoid the use of spreaders which may apply the product in narrow, concentrated or uneven bands. Calibrate your spreader according to the spreader manufacturer's directions to ensure the proper amount of MERIT 0.2 G is applied. Check frequently to be sure spreader is working properly and spreading granules evenly.

After Applying: MERIT 0.2 G will work best if the lawn is watered thoroughly or if rainfall occurs within 24 hours after application to move the active ingredient through the thatch and down into the soil. Avoid mowing lawn until watering or rainfall has occurred so that the uniformity of the granules is not disturbed.

When to Apply: MERIT 0.2 G works best when applied before grubs and mole crickets hatch.


For best results,	apply as	follows:
-------------------	----------	----------

White grubs	Apply once, anytime from April through mid- August.
Mole crickets	In Florida, apply once from early April through early May. Elsewhere, apply once from mid-May through mid-June.

DO NOT apply MERIT 0.2 G when turf areas are waterlogged. The product may not work effectively under these conditions.

How Much to Apply: For control of white grubs, MERIT 0.2 G should be applied at the rate of 2.87 pounds per 1,000 square feet. For mole cricket control, apply 3.8 pounds per 1000 square feet. The table below can be used as a guide for applying the proper rate of MERIT 0.2 G. However, the application rate can vary depending on the speed of application and the condition of the spreader. For best results, use a normal, steady pace when applying to obtain an accurate, even application.

APPLICATION TO LANDSCAPE PLANTINGS

(Trees, Shrubs, Evergreens, Flowers, Ground covers)

<u>Pests Controlled:</u> White grubs (including larvae of Japanese beetle, Oriental beetle, chafers, Asiatic garden beetle, May and June beetle, and black turfgrass ataenius).

<u>How to Apply:</u> Apply as a broadcast treatment to soil, mulch or other substrate. Prior to application, remove black plastic from area to be treated to allow water to penetrate into the soil. Permeable weed barriers need not be removed prior to application.

After Applying: MERIT 0.2 G will work best if material is worked into the soil around plants or if a thorough watering or rainfall occurs within 24 hours after application to move the product down through mulch and into the soil.

When to Apply: The best control of grubs will be obtained if MERIT 0.2 G is applied before grubs begin to hatch. For best

results, application should occur from April through mid-August.

DO NOT apply to waterlogged areas. MERIT may not work effectively under these conditions.

How Much to Apply: MERIT 0.2 G should be applied at the rate of 2.87 pounds per 1,000 square feet. This 15 pound bag will treat 5,000 square feet of landscaped area. The table above can be used as a guide for applying the proper rate of MERIT 0.2 G. However, the application rate can vary depending on the speed of application and the condition of the spreader.

NOTE: DO NOT apply MERIT 0.2 G to vegetable gardens.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Container Disposal: Do not re-use bag. Wrap and dispose of in trash.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place.
