If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Administer water freely and induce vomiting by giving one dose (1/2 oz or 15 mL) of syrup of ipecac. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by sticking finger down throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious

GENERAL INFORMATION

TEMPO 1% Dust Insecticide is a ready-to-use insecticide dust which provides effective knockdown and residual control of the pests listed on the next page.

TEMPO 1% Dust Insecticide is for residual pest control in and around livestock and poultry housing facilities. Permitted areas of use include, but are not limited to, livestock housing structures, poultry houses, swine houses, cattle barns, horse stables and pet kennels.

INDOOR PESTS

Apply dust using hand or power dusters or other suitable equipment. Apply lightly and uniformly to infested areas. Pay particular attention to floors, walls and bedding, as well as, cracks and crevices; wall voids and around window and door frames. Apply 0.5 to 1 pound of TEMPO 1% Dust Insecticide per thousand square feet. Do not make applications of TEMPO 1% Dust when animals are present in area of facility to be treated. Do not apply directly to animal feedstuffs or watering equipment. Repeat treatments as necessary to maintain adequate control.

OUTDOOR/PERIMETER PESTS

Make a residual treatment in voids, cracks and crevices in window and door frames, between elements of construction or void areas in door porches, eaves and in crawl spaces and other areas where pests hide.

To help prevent invasion of structures by the listed outdoor pests, treat soil or other substrate adjacent to structure using TEMPO 1% Dust, TEMPO 20 WP or TEMPO 2 as per the registered label. Also treat the structure foundation where pests are active and may find entrance.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
