

- e. \_\_We assume measuring utensils will be supplied with product. Since reference is made to tablespoons add following precaution to precautionary statements, "Food utensils such as teaspoons and measuring cups should not be used for food purposes after use with insecticide."
- f. "New" may be used for a period of 6 months after release of the product from the marketplace. Claims marked with an "x" are unacceptable. Claims implying total eradication of pests, or vague, non-specific terms are unacceptable. "Keeps killing for weeks" is unacceptable because it conflicts with "reapply to 7 to 14 days, if needed."


