Dear Mr. Thornton:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Delete the phrase "LOW ODOR" from the front panel of the label. "New" may used only for a period of 6 months after the release of the product in the marketplace. "Low Odor" is a subjective statement and there are no product chemistry data to support this claim...
- 2. Add the statement "Food Utensils such as teaspoons and measuring cups should not be used for food purposes after use with this insecticide" to your Precautionary Statements.
- 3. Add the signal word "CAUTION" to the ½ fl oz tube label.
- 4. Delete all phrases that say "Keeps on Killing for Weeks". This directly contradicts your statement of "repeat every 7 to 14 days as necessary".

- 6. Please change the statement "Effective Against Broad Range of Pests" to read "Effective Against Broad Range of Listed Pests".
- 7. Under the FOR BEST RESULTS section, please change the first sentence to read "Do not water the foliage within one hour after applying".
- 8. Under the BEFORE YOU USE section, please add in the bulleted statement "Remove animal feeding dishes prior to application. Keep children and pets away from treated areas until the spray has dried".
- 9. Delete the phrase "ADVANCED PROTECTION FORMULA" from the front of your label. There has been no change in your CSF since the previously approved label.
- 10. Add the following statement to the front panel "See back panel/booklet for ingredients and precautionary statements."
- 11. Add "Causes Eye Irritation" beneath the signal word on the front panel.
