Amendment - Label Revision

Tempo Ready-to-Use

Your submissions dated March 5, 1999

Dear Mr. Thornton:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Delete the phrases: "LOW ODOR" and "ADVANCED PROTECTION FORMULA" from the front panel of the label. "New" may used only for a period of 6 months after the release of the product in the marketplace. "Low Odor" is a subjective statement and there is no product chemistry data to support this claim. Further, there has been no change to the formula since the initial registration.
- 2. Delete all phrases that say "Keeps on Killing for Weeks". This directly contradicts your statement of "repeat every 7 to 14 days as necessary".
- 3. On your previous label (accepted on February 1, 1999), under the "Quick Facts" section, the label indicates that a 24 fl oz container can treat about 50 medium size plants. On the current label, you indicate that a 24 fl oz container can only treat about 24 medium size

- 4. Delete the phrase "Kills on Contact". There is no efficacy data to support this claim.
- 5. Please change the statement "Effective Against Broad Range of Pests" to read "Effective Against Broad Range of Listed Pests".
- 6. Under the FOR BEST RESULTS section, please change the first sentence to read "Do not water the foliage within one hour after applying".
- 7. Under the HOUSEHOLD NUISANCE PESTS OUTDOORS section, please change the sentence to read "Children and pets may re-enter the treated area after the spray has dried".
- 8. Under the BEFORE YOU USE section, please add in the bulleted statement "Apply the product to flowering plants during early morning or late evening, when bees are not present."
- 9. Make the following change to this statement on the front panel "See back panel/booklet for ingredients and precautionary statements."
- 10. Delete "Kills Pests Outdoors Before They Come Inside" and replace with "Kills Nuisance Pests" or "Kills Household Nuisance Pests Outdoors". The product is for outdoor use only.






