Dear Mr. Thornton:

This letter supercedes our letter of November 1, 1999. The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the finished labeling before you release the product for shipment.

- 1. Reinstate the statement "For Outdoor Residential Use Only" to the front panel of the label.
2. Delete the phrase: "ADVANCED GARDEN" from the front panel of the label.
3. Change the phrase "Lawn" on the front panel of your label to "Ornamental".
4. Add the statement "For Outdoor Residential Use Only" to the front panel of the label.
5. Under the FOR BEST RESULTS section, add the following statement: "To avoid serious damage to plants, eliminate pests early in the season."

PESTS

Ants, Boxelder bugs, Clover mites, Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Flies, Midges, Mosquitoes, Pillbugs, Sowbugs, Spiders, Wasps

**HOW TO
APPLY**

Spray around doors, window frames and other places where insects may enter house. Spray around foundations and porches. Spray on ant hills and ant trails.



Children and pets may re-enter the treated area after the spray has dried.
