In addition, please revise the header entitled "Responsible Use" to read as "Use Precautions." The Agency views the heading "Responsible Use" as unacceptable. This heading implies the guidelines are optional directions for use rather than mandatory directions for use.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Swallowing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If the person is able to swallow:</li><li>• Have them sip 1 to 2 glassfuls of water.</li><li>• Call a doctor or poison control center for further treatment advice.</li></ul>
Inhalation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If breathing is affected, move person to fresh air.</li><li>• Contact doctor or poison control center for further treatment advice.</li><li>• If not breathing, call an ambulance and give artificial respiration.</li></ul>
Contact with skin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Remove contaminated clothing.</li><li>• Wash affected skin with soap and warm water.</li><li>• Call a doctor if irritation occurs.</li></ul>
Contact with eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water.</li><li>• Continue to rinse eye for 10 to 15 minutes.</li><li>• Call a doctor if irritation persists.</li></ul>

Note to Physicians: No specific antidote is available. Treat the patient symptomatically.

**Environmental  
Hazards**

- Toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water.
- Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.
- When cleaning equipment, do not pour the rinse water on the ground. Spray or drain over a large area away from wells and other water sources.
- Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from target area.

Most cases of groundwater contamination involving phenoxy herbicides such as 2,4-D and MCPP have been associated with mixing/loading and disposal sites. Caution should be exercised when handling 2,4-D and MCPP pesticides at such sites to prevent contamination of groundwater supplies.

Use of closed systems for mixing and transferring this pesticide will reduce the probability of spills. Placement of the mixing/loading equipment on an impervious pad to contain spills will help prevent ground-water contamination.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Be sure to read and follow all label directions.

Do not apply this product in flower or vegetable beds, around shrubs or ornamental plants. Avoid spray drift to landscape plants as injury may occur.

**To achieve the best results:**

- Apply this product when weeds are actively growing.
- Apply this product when air temperatures are between 60° to 85°F.
- Apply this product to a freshly mowed lawn. If soil is dry, water one to two days prior to application.
- Do not water within 24 hours after treatment. Rainfall after spraying may result in poor weed control.
- Do not apply to new lawns until the grass has reached a height of at least 2 inches.
- Do retreat after two to three weeks if certain hard-to-kill weeds regrow.

To use responsibly, follow these guidelines when applying:

- **Do not** allow spray to drift to desirable plants or injury may result. Spray when the air is calm and carefully direct spray at weeds to avoid injury to landscape plants.
- **Do not** spray when outside temperatures exceed 85 °F or damage to lawn may occur.
- **Do not** allow people or pets to enter the treated area until it has dried completely.
- **Do not** use this product on Floratam, Dichondra, Carpetgrass or lawns containing desirable clovers. Avoid spraying the roots of trees and ornamentals.
- **Important:** Do not treat the entire lawn more than two times per year.

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#### How to Use

Spray the entire lawn, covering both weeds and grass until wet. Avoid saturating lawn or allowing spray to drift to desirable plants. Repeat application if certain hardy weeds are not dead within three weeks.

1. Shake well before use.
2. Connect garden hose to nozzle. Make sure the [color inserted here] water control valve on top of the spray nozzle is in the "OFF" position.
3. Turn on water at faucet. Extend hose to the farthest area to be treated and work back towards faucet to avoid walking over treated areas. Twist the small star-shaped [color inserted here] product control button to align the flat portion with the lock tab. Push the button in to open.
4. To begin spraying, point nozzle toward the area to be treated and turn the [color inserted here] water control valve to the "ON" position (tab is horizontal). Water will automatically mix with the product.
5. Walk at a steady pace while spraying, using an even sweeping motion, slightly overlapping treated areas.
6. To stop spraying, turn the [color inserted here] water control valve to the "OFF" position. Push the small round button opposite the small star-shaped [color inserted here] product control button in to close. Turn off water at faucet. To relieve pressure in hose, turn the [color inserted here] water control valve to the "ON" position until water stops spraying before removing the nozzle from hose.
7. To store unused container, place in a cool, dry area away from heat and freezing temperatures. Keep away from children.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

##### Storage Conditions

Store in original container, out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage cabinet. Protect from freezing. (3.)

##### Disposal

- Do not reuse empty product containers.
- Rinse the empty container thoroughly.
- Include rinse water in application.
- Place empty container in trash.

**Important:** It is best to use all of the product in accordance with label directions. If it is necessary to dispose of unused product, please follow all state and local guidelines.
