- d. Revise the first sentence under the header entitled "Responsible Use" to read as "Follow these guidelines when applying:" in the Direction For Use section.

In addition, please revise the header entitled "Responsible Use" to read as "Use Precautions". The Agency views the heading "Responsible Use" as unacceptable. This heading implies the guidelines/directions are optional directions for use rather than mandatory directions for use.

- e. Under the Storage and Disposal statement, please revise the fourth statement to read as "Place empty container in trash."
- f. Under the Precautionary Statements section in the First Aid box, there is a typographical error in section entitled "Note". Please change "you" to "You".
- g. Incorporate the company's name and address on the subject product's labeling.

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
