Dear Mr. Thornton:

This letter supercedes our letter of November 1, 1999. The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the finished labeling before you release the product for shipment.

- Reinstate the statement "For Indoor/Outdoor Residential Use Only" to a position above 1. the "Keep Out of Reach of Children" statement".
- Add the phrase "vapors or " to the statement "Avoid breathing spray mist" under the Precautionary Statements section. This was brought to your attention in our previous letter.

Since the labeling submitted with your October 22, 1999 letter is substantially similar to that approved on July 28, 1999, is in finished format and the above requested revisions do not raise risk concerns associated with the use of this product, we will allow you to use this labeling
