

DIRECTIONS FOR USING DUROX BLEACH

ENZYMES

DUROX disinfects, cleans, and removes stains that enzyme products cannot. Use **DUROX** with any good detergent.

FABRICS

- Use **DUROX** on the following fabrics: (If the fabrics are white or colorfast.) Cotton, Nylon, Rayon, Linen, Polyester (Dacron), Acrylic (Orlon), Acetate (Chromspun), Triacetate (Arnel), Modacrylic (Dy-nel), blends of these fabrics.
- **PERMANENT PRESS** fabrics, both white and colorfast, are bleachable.
- **DO NOT USE** on silk, wool, mohair, leather, spandex, nonfast colors. Dilute before use on any fabric.
- **BLEACH COLORFAST:** Most colorfast fabrics are bleachable. To test, before laundering with **DUROX** soak non-noticeable portion of the fabric 5 minutes in a solution of 1 Tablespoon **DUROX** to 1 gallon of hot, sudsy water.
- **BABY FABRICS AND DIAPERS:** Flush out soiled diaper before laundering. Use 1 Tablespoon per gallon water if odor-reducing pre-soak is desirable. **DUROX** kills many bacteria that normal wash water temperatures do not.

USAGE

- Top-Load Automatics — 1 cup per load
- Front-Load Automatics — 1/2 cup per load
- Wringer-Type Washers — 1 cup per load

Add **DUROX** to wash water before laundry is put in or . . . add **DUROX** to one quart of water and add after fabrics are thoroughly wet.

STAINS

- MUSTARD
- GRASS
- FRUIT
- INK
- CHOCOLATE
- COFFEE, TEA
- MILDEW
- CATSUP
- DIAPER STAINS
- SCORCH
- VEGETABLE
- COLLAR DIRT

DUROX and detergent work better in a greater number of cleaning situations than enzyme detergent alone or enzyme pre-soak and a detergent wash.

The above stains and most others will be removed with a good detergent and **DUROX**.

Egg, milk, blood and other protein based stain or any particular stubborn stain can be soaked in a solution

of 1 cup **DUROX** per 2 gallons of cool, sudsy water for 5-10 minutes. Rinse. Use regular wash with **DUROX** and detergent to follow.

CLEANING AND DISINFECTING

- **DISHES:** 1 Tablespoon **DUROX** per gallon water. Rinse, dry.
- **FLOORS:** (Do not use on cork or linoleum.) On plastic or ceramic tile use **DUROX** and sudsy water. (3/4 cup **DUROX** per gallon.)
- **TOILET BOWLS:** Pour 1 cup **DUROX** around inside. Swab or brush entire inner bowl surface. After 5 minutes, flush. (See caution below.)
- **BATHTUBS, Refrigerators, Stoves, Sinks, Tile, Woodwork:** With 1/2 cup **DUROX** per gallon water, wipe, then rinse. For most stubborn stains, allow 10 minutes soak time with **DUROX**. (Don't use **DUROX** on aluminum, silver, steel, or chipped enamel. Don't use natural sponge.)
- **GARBAGE CANS:** To reduce odor, pour a solution of 1 cup **DUROX** per gallon water. Allow 5-10 minutes. Wash.
- **SICK ROOM EQUIPMENT:** After washing, soak for 10 minutes in solution of 1/2 cup **DUROX** per gallon of hot water.

CAUTION:

If **DUROX** is splashed in eyes, flood with water. If **DUROX** is swallowed, feed milk. **CALL PHYSICIAN.** If **DUROX** is splashed on skin, wash off with water.

DO NOT USE AMMONIA OR TOILET BOWL CLEANERS WITH DUROX. To do so will release hazardous gases. Do not use this

bottle for storage of any liquid except **DUROX**. Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.
