FOR BLEACHING
LAUNDRY — SAVES
 — SAVES

SANTA FE bleaches white cottons and removes stains. No boiling necessary. Use for fabrics on silks or woolens.
 WASHING MACHINE—Use ½ tea cup SANTA FE in warm water. Less soap is required and half the usual time.
 TUB WASHING—Use 1 tablespoon SANTA FE in water, mixed thoroughly. Use less soap 2 or 3 times.
 RINSE WATER BLEACH (instead of at the end of wash) add 1 spoon SANTA FE to each gallon of water and soak 10 minutes. Then rinse two times.

FOR REMOVING STAINS INK, COFFEE, TEA, GRASS, SCORCH, ETC.

Use only on white or color-fast cottons. Soak in cold water. Then soak article in 1 to 2 tablespoons SANTA FE to one-quart cold water if necessary. Rinse well. If a mildewed article, soak 10 minutes before use.

CAUTION: Use as directed. Keep in a cool place out of reach of children. SWALLOWED. Prolonged irritation. KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN. DO NOT USE ON WOOL OR SILK.

SANTA FE bleaches white cottons and linens. Removes ordinary stains. No boiling necessary. Use for fast colors only. Do NOT use on silks or woollens.

WASHING MACHINE—Use ½ tea cup SANTA FE to machine with warm water. Less soap is required and washer will only be run one-half the usual time.

TUB WASHING—Use 1 tablespoon SANTA FE to each gallon warm water, mixed thoroughly. Use less soap. Soak 30 minutes. Rinse 2 or 3 times.

RINSE WATER BLEACH (instead of above methods): Use 1 table-spoon SANTA FE to each gallon of water in first rinse. Let clothes soak 10 minutes. Then rinse two times in clear water.

**FOR
REMOVING
STAINS**

**INK, COFFEE, FRUIT,
TEA, GRASS, MILDEW,
SCORCH, ETC.**

Use only on white or color-fast cottons or linens. If starched, first soak in cold water. Then soak article 10 minutes in solution of 2 tablespoons SANTA FE to one-quart cold water, mixed well. Repeat if necessary. Rinse well. If a mildewed article dry in sun.

CAUTION:

Use as directed. Keep upright, tightly capped, in a cool place out of reach of children. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. Prolonged contact may cause skin irritation. KEEP AWAY FROM EYES. NOT FOR PERSONAL USE. **DO NOT USE WITH AMMONIA.**

CLEANING**

**CLEANSSES AND DEODORIZES
ENAMELED METAL,
WOOD, TILE, ETC.**

Ideal for drainboards, sinks, refrigerators, enamelware, oilcloth, linoleum, tile, wooden utensils, woodwork, etc. Destroys odors of fish, onions, etc.—Use 3 tablespoons SANTA FE to quart of water, mixed well. Apply to surface: wait five minutes, rinse with clear water.

For Dishwashing: Use 3 tablespoons of SANTA FE to each quart of dishwater. Use less soap. Rinse well.

For disinfecting sickroom utensils, garbage cans, etc., first wash in sudsy water and rinse. Then apply solution 3 tablespoons SANTA FE to quart of warm water; let stand on surface 5 minutes; then rinse and dry.
