Place dog on a table or bench, prefer-
ably out of doors. Hold bottle in an up-
right position about 3 - 8 inches from
the dog and continue to pump until
animal's coat gets an even covering of
liqui-ban. Spray all over the body
against the lay of the coat. Avoid
spraying in eyes. Spray to leave coat
slightly damp down to the skin level.

One treatment will kill fleas and pro-
tect against reinfestation for up to
one month. Repeat treatment as
necessary.

Storage & Disposal

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap
in newspaper and put in trash collec-
tion. Do not store near heat.
