DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For Veterinary Use Only

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To operate, remove regular cap. Replace with pump. Remove cap from nozzle.

Place dog on a table or bench, preferably out of doors. Hold bottle in an upright position about 3-6 inches from the dog and continue to pump until animal's coat gets an even covering of **liqui-ban**. Spray all over the body against the lay of the coat. Avoid spraying in eyes. Spray to leave coat slightly damp down to the skin level. One treatment will kill fleas and protect against reinfestation for up to one month. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Storage & Disposal

Do not store near heat. Store in original container in a safe place. Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly and wrap in several layers of newspaper before discarding in trash.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals:

May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors.

Note to Physician: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote, by injection only.

Statement of Practical Treatment:
If Swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger.

If On Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water.

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If Inhaled: Remove from exposure, establish adequate airway, give oxygen or artificial respiration as indicated.

Do not use on cats.

Free bitches from fleas before they bear pups. Do not use on dogs nursing puppies or on pups under 10 weeks old.
