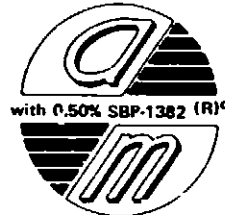

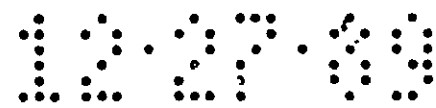

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. Surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed after use. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the product is not in operation.

SPACE SPRAY: To kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats: Close room or tent and turn off air conditioner and ventilator system. Seal all open vents. Remove fishbowl as a very fine mist space spray through manually operated equipment or through powered applicators. Avoid staining by holding the spray nozzle at least 12 inches from the surface. Direct the fine spray mist toward the upper corner of the room. Fill space spray at the rate of 3 fluid ounces per 5,000 cubic feet. Leave for 1 hour. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy insects.

CONTACT SPRAYS: To kill roaches, ants, earwigs, grain mites and centipedes: Adjust spray to produce large wetting type spray pattern. Spray these insects in cracks and crevices in floors, baseboards, around pipes and other harborages. Spray these infested areas until thoroughly wet. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SPIDERS: Spray directly on these pests and use repeated applications until all cracks and crevices which harbor spiders are thoroughly wet.

TO KILL ANTS: Spray doors, around window frames, ant trails and hidden areas.

TO KILL GRAIN INSECTS: Adults of confused flour beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles: Remove infested grain cereal or flour and destroy. Adults of other grain insects: Remove infested grain cereal or flour and destroy. Remove food and foodstuffs in the areas by removing before spraying. Spray into cracks and crevices where grain insects may be hiding. In hot areas, the shelves and drawers should be cleaned and thoroughly washed with water and covered with shelf paper after allowing shelves to dry. Any remaining insects should be washed before using. Repeat as necessary.

THERMAL APPLICATION - This formulation is to be used with thermal applicator equipment that can deliver spray particle sizes with a median diameter of 10 microns or less.

THERMAL APPLICATIONS INDOORS-For control of flies, mosquitoes, and other flying insects: Shut off ventilating systems, air ducts, air conditioning systems, and close off room or area to be treated.

Apply as a dry fog at the rate of 1/6 fluid ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Leave for at least 2 hours. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate.
