**FOR DAIRY CATTLE
 AND BEEF ANIMALS.**

To protect dairy and beef animals from face flies, house flies, stable flies and horn flies apply a light application (1 to 2 fluid ounces) daily as a fine mist. Spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including the legs.

Do not apply in excess of 2 fluid ounces per animal per day.

Do not apply regularly to calves under 6 months of age.

Do not treat Brahman cattle as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.
