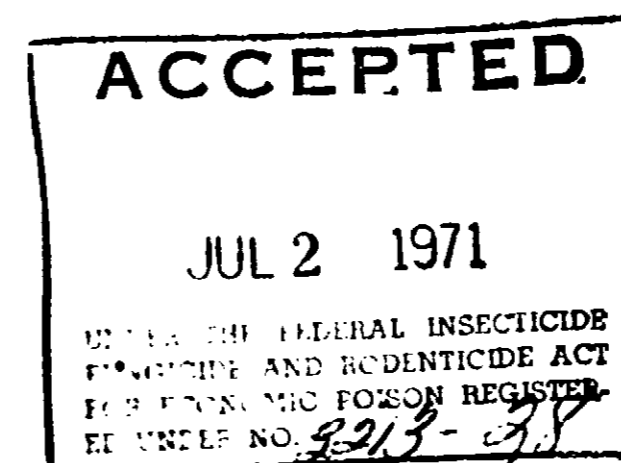

FEEDING DIRECTIONS:
