

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used as a dust without dilution in conventional ground-air dusters. Dusts should be applied when the wind velocity is less than 5 miles per hour. The best hours for dusting are usually between 10:00 P. M. and 4:00 A. M.

BEANS: For the control of Rust and Powdery Mildew and for manganese deficiency of beans. Apply at the rate of 20 to 40 lbs. per acre, repeated at 7 to 10 day intervals to within 10 days of harvest. For the most effective control should be started before leaves are infected. The control obtained before flowering has more effect on yield than control late in the crop season.

PEANUTS: For the control of Early and Late Leaf Spot diseases (usually combined with 5% Basic Copper Sulfate), and for correction of manganese deficiency of peanuts. Apply at the rate of 20 to 25 lbs. per acre at 7 to 10 day intervals, as necessary. Begin dusting when diseases first appear and continue to within one month of harvest.
