DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CITRUS (Florida) — Grapefruit, Lemons, Limes, Oranges, Tangelos and Tangerines:

SUMMER APPLICATION: *Glover, chaff and yellow scale* - use 1/2 gallon per 100 gallons of water; *purple scale* - use 3/5 gallon per 100 gallons of water; *Florida red scale, greasy spot* - use 4/5 gallon of product per 100 gallons of water; *black and brown soft scale, whiteflies* - use 1 gallon per 100 gallons of water.

Best results can be obtained when the oil is added to a partially filled spray tank under proper agitation and all foliage is thoroughly covered.

Precautions in the use of oil include: Do not apply oil spray when trees are wilting or near wilting. Do not apply oil and sulphur within 3 weeks of each other. Oil spray applied after October 1 may increase susceptibility of trees to cold damage and may reduce the fruit crop the following year. Oil sprays applied in the fall may inhibit solids formation in the juice and retard coloring of fruit, and should not be applied within 60 days of anticipated harvest. Sensitive foliage may be injured.

Consult the Florida Citrus Spray and Dust Schedule, or your State Agricultural Experiment Station or State Extension Service Specialist for complete details on the spraying program best suited to your local conditions.
