The Agency is in receipt of your Application for Pesticide Notification under Pesticide Registration Notice (PRN) 2007-4 dated May 21, 2008 for the product Rampage Mouse Seed Ready-to-Use Place Pac (EPA Registration Number 3240-28). The Registration Division (RD) has conducted its review of this request for its applicability under PRN 2007-4 and finds that the label changes requested fall within the scope of PRN 2007-4. The label submitted with the application has been stamped "Notification" and will be placed in our records.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on nonrefillable containers. Section II (Explanation)

Notification of label change per PR Notice 2007-4. This notification is consistent with the guidance in PR Notice 2007-4 and the requirements of EPA's regulations at 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156. No other changes have been made to the labeling or the Confidential Statement of Formula for this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statements to EPA. I further understand that if the amended label is not consistent with the requirements of 40 CFR §§ 156.10, 156.140, 156.144, 156.146, and 156.156, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

- Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from bait stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
- Dispose of product container and unused, spoiled, or unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

JSE RESTRICTIONS: For control of house mice in nd around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, nd similar man-made structures. Do not place bait in reas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or urfaces that come in direct contact with food. When sed in USDA-inspected facilities, this product must be pplied in tamper-resistant bait stations. Do not broadcast ait.

ELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine reas where mice will most likely find and consume the ait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed penings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed laces, between floors and walls, or in locations where odents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from ain and snow. Remove as much alternative food as ossible.

AICE: Apply 1 to 2 Place Pacs at 8 to 12 foot intervals. arger placements (up to 3 Place Pacs) may be needed at oints of very high a monse cactivity. Maintain an ninterrupted supply of fresh-bait for at least 55 days.

Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead, exposed animals and leftover bait. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.
