

Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Protect bait from rain and snow. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

RATS: Apply 2 to 8 Place Pacs (usually at intervals of 15 to 30 feet) per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days.

MICE: Apply 1 Place Pac at 8 to 12 foot intervals. placements (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of v mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply bait for at least 15 days.

FOLLOW-UP: Replace contaminated or spoil immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead, animals and leftover bait. To prevent reinfestation sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as a possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat tr. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.
