DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON FARMS

Before using milking machines, milker pails, hoses, bulk tanks, or any surface to be contacted by milk, sanitize with solution (200 PPM) containing 1 oz. GRADE A SANITIZER to 2½ gallons of clean (90° - 95°) water, by spraying or circulating.

Do not rinse with water after sanitizing.

Following installation or repair of WELL, treat with GRADE A SANITIZER. Consult with local Health Department for quantity to be used.

RECOMMENDED

DILUTIONS SANITIZING

All surfaces should be completely clean before sanitizing.

Milking machines, milk cans, pails, strainers, and milk pipe lines---

200 PPM

1 oz. GRADE A SANITIZER to 2½ gallons water.

Poultry farms, brooders, incubators, poultry houses, spray with—

800 PPM

8 oz. GRADE A SANITIZER to 5 gallons water. "Note" be sure all litter is removed and all floors are washed and rinsed thoroughly before spraying.

Consult local Health Authorities when in doubt as to proper dilutions for any sanitizing problem.

Bleaching With GRADE A SANITIZER

Fast color or white, cotton and linens—

1 oz. GRADE A SANITIZER to 2 gallons rinse water.

Stir thoroughly before putting in cottons or linens.

Stain removal — coffee, tea, fruit, mildew, grass or medicine

1 oz. GRADE A SANITIZER to 1 gallon water.

Soak for 10 minutes.

Rinse thoroughly.
