DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON FARMS

Before using milking machines, milk pails, hoses, bulk tanks, or any surface to be sanitized by milk sanitizer, solution: 200 PPM containing 1 oz. AL-CLOR 6.6 SANITIZER to 2 1/2 gallons of clean 90-95% water, by spraying and rinsing.

Do not mix with water after sanitizing.

Following installation, use on pipes and walls with AL-CLOR 6.6 SANITIZER. Consult with local health department for quantity table and

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING

Always use proper dilution. Do not mix with other sanitizers. Do not use on surfaces that are not compatible with chlorine. Do not use on surfaces that are not clean.

NON-POROUS SURFACES
