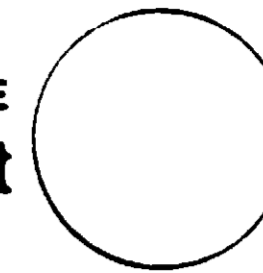

DIRECTIONS FOR MIXING CONCENTRATE

Use a disposable container, such as a double plastic utility bag. Carefully follow the mixing recipe below.

1. Place into mixing bag 3 pounds of breakfast cereal (oats or rolled oats) and 1/2 cup of corn oil, then 1/2 pound rice mixed with 1/2 pound of bread or bread crumbs.

2. Mix or shake bag vigorously for 2 minutes.

3. Then add 1/2 pound of confectionary sugar, 1 pound flour, and 1/2 pound of d-CON Concentrate.

4. Mix or shake bag vigorously for 3 to 5 minutes until contents is thoroughly mixed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use disposable containers, such as plastic dishes or paper plates, as bait trays.

TO KILL NORWAY AND ROOF RATS: Place 4 to 16 ounces of bait in each tray. Maintain a fresh supply of bait for at least 10 days.

TO KILL HOUSE MICE: Place 1/4 to 1/2 ounce of bait (about a tablespoon) in each tray. Place trays at 8 to 12 foot intervals. Maintain a fresh supply of bait for at least 15 days.

BAIT PLACEMENT

Place bait trays in areas where rats and mice feed, water, or travel. Best places are along walls, in corners, and in dark, out-of-the-way areas. Cover trays with bait box or board. Never place trays out in the open.

Allow trays to remain undisturbed for at least 2 days. After 2 days, check bait trays for evidence of consumption. If half the contents are consumed, place a new fresh tray in the same location. Check again 2 days later and if necessary, add new trays until a complete lack of feeding is noted.

Evidence of rat or mouse runs in 3 days. For complete control, continue baiting for at least 15 days. If there is danger of reinfestation, try a different type of bait, set up permanent bait stations. Check these bait stations periodically. Remove any spoiled or contaminated bait and replace promptly with fresh bait.

IMPORTANT: Bait should be placed in areas as far as possible from drains, pits, walls, floors, and other structures where rodents can tamper with the bait.

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or dust spraying. Wash all equipment thoroughly as soon as possible.

Keep bait and concentrate in a safe, unattended place. For safety, keep children away from the empty plastic concentrate in the bait tray. Wash the empty tray when the bait has been used. Do not reuse the tray for any other purpose.
