**DIRECTIONS**

**TO MIX:** Stir contents of this packet in one quart of water.

**TO USE:** Pour this liquid bait into glass, plastic or crockery dishes. Avoid use of metal containers. Place bait in different locations where rats and mice are known to feed. Never place bait where humans, pets, poultry or livestock can drink it. Rats and mice have to drink liquid bait for 5 to 14 days. Replace any cloudy solution. For mice, make more frequent placements. Repeat until you are certain there is no further rodent activity.

**CAUTION:** Place bait stations so as to protect children, pets and domestic animals. d-CON WARFICIDE contains as its active ingredient an anticoagulant chemical which, if taken accidentally by humans, domestic animals and pets, may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and a serious hemorrhage may result. In case d-CON WARFICIDE is accidentally consumed, call physician immediately. Give patient 1 tablespoonful of salt in glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear.

**NOTICE TO PHYSICIAN:** When a human has been known to have accidentally consumed d-CON WARFICIDE, blood transfusions combined with intravenous injections and oral doses of vitamin K are indicated as in the case of hemorrhage caused by overdoses of dicumarol.
