Your Submissions Dated August 26, 1988, February 2, 1989, and August 20, 1989, respectively.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Plant Disease Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

For EPA Registration No. 3282-25, delete the reference to methylene chloride on your label since it no longer is an ingredient in your product.

For EPA Registration No. 3282-29, you must address the following:

1. Check with your supplier concerning the status of petroleum distillate as an active ingredient. If you choose to propose amending the registration to include the petroleum distillate as an active ingredient, revise the label to show "Contains petroleum distillate" as a substatement in the ingredient statement.
2. If your label contains the statement "Contains petroleum distillate" delete "If foot contact surfaces become contaminated, wash thoroughly" and replace with "All foot contact surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use."

**DIRECTIONS**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake before using. Not for indoor use. Do not smoke while spraying. Cover exposed food. Point valve opening away from face and angled slightly downward. Do not apply to food crops or pets. For best results, use when air is calm or breeze is slight. Keep spray 4-6 feet away from ornamental plants.

**FOR FLYING INSECTS:** Flies (including DDT-resistant strains) Mosquitoes, Gnats, Hornets, Wasps, Small Flying Moths. Spray with the breeze and allow fog to drift over area. When treating grass or brushes, stand at least 4 to 6 feet away and drift spray on area. Repeat as necessary.

**FOR CRAWLING INSECTS:** Ants, Crickets, Centipedes. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area. Spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills and trails thoroughly.
