1. Shake before using.
2. Point valve opening away from face and spray slightly downward. Press button down to activate fogger spray.
3. Spray plants from a distance of 4-6 feet, letting fog drift into area being treated. Cover all parts of plants lightly with spray.
4. For extra heavy growth, spray plants on both sides to assure complete coverage. Repeat treatment as needed.

For best results spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is calm or breeze is light.

For use on insects listed below on small ornamental plants: Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Gladioli, Delphiniums, Gladioli, Irises, Marigolds, Fuchsias, and Impatiens.

Also for insects listed below on Evergreens, Shrubs, Vines and Small Ornamental Deciduous Trees.

**Sucking Insects**  
Aphids, Leafhoppers, Spotted Mites, Trips (exposed), and Lace Bugs.

**Chewing Insects**  
Flea Beetles, Mexican Bean Beetles, Japanese Beetles, Southern Army Worm Larvae (cutworms), Girdling Cutworms, Hornworms, and Pine Sawflies.

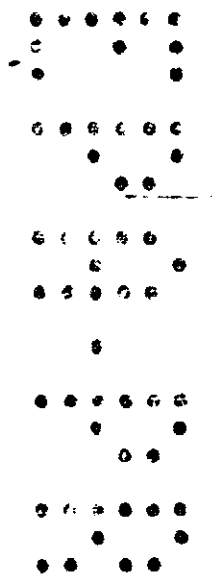
**Note:** All insects listed above must be contacted directly with spray. Also for Aphids, Leafhoppers, Girdling Cutworms on Tomatoes, Flea Beetles, Mexican Bean Beetles and Girdling Cutworm Beetles on Apples. For Imported Cabbageworm and Larva of the Cabbage Butterfly on Cabbages, apply as described above, repeating the application at weekly intervals if necessary.

**DO NOT APPLY ON TOMATOES, BRUSSEL SPROUTS OR CABBAGE LATER THAN 7 DAYS BEFORE HARVEST.**

3. Spray plants from a distance of 4 to 6 feet, allowing a drift into area being treated. Cover all parts of plant thoroughly with spray.
4. For extra heavy growth, spray plants on both sides to assure complete coverage. Repeat treatment as needed.

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day, when air is calm or breeze is slight.

For use on insects listed below on many ornamental plants: Asters, Anemones, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Clematis, Delphiniums, Gladioli, Irises, Narcissus, Petunias, Roses and Foxgloves.

Also for insects listed below on Evergreens, Fruits, Vines and Small Ornamental Deciduous Trees.

**Sucking Insects:**  
Aphids, Leafhoppers, Spotted Mites, Trips (exposed) and Leaf Louse.

**Chewing Insects:**  
Fire Beetles, Mexican Bean Beetles, Japanese Beetles, Southern Armyworm, Large Leafhopper, Girdling Cutworms, Hornworms, and Pine Sawflies.

Note: A larva's body must be contacted directly with spray.

Also for Aphids, Leafhoppers, Girdling Cutworms on Tomatoes; for Aphids, Leafhoppers, and Spotted Mites on Garden Beetles in the soil.

For ornamental plants, use only on the foliage of the plant.

Do not apply to any plants or surfaces until 7 days after application.

DO NOT APPLY TO ANY PLANTS OR SURFACES UNTIL 7 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

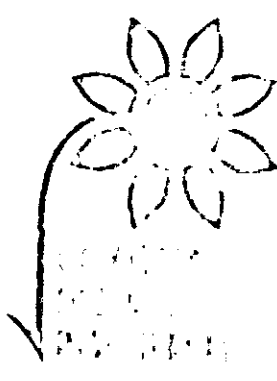
