# d-CON flying insect killer formula II

### DIRECTIONS

For household use only. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Hold Container Upright. Point spray nozzle away from face and press button.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats. Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as necessary.

To kill Ants and Crickets. Contact as many insects as possible with spray. In addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, in door sills, as under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat drains, around window frames, ant traps and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To kill exposed forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles and Rice Weevils. Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks. Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and torn areas of floors. Also treat mats and rugs with registered flea and tick control product. Wash and disinfect pet's quarters area. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

##### CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water. Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage, or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces, exposed food and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

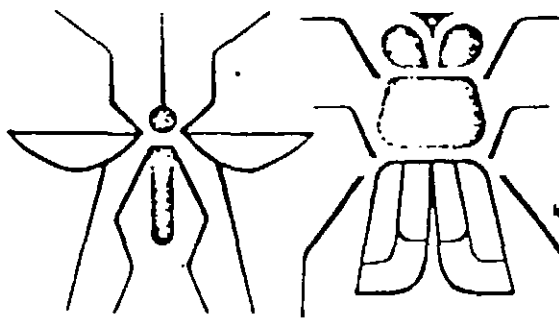

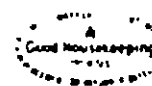

- \* To Kill Fleas and Ticks on Dogs and Cats: Apply directly to animal's back, under fore-legs, and other areas except scrotum and anus. Part hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about one foot away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not spray directly in eyes or mouth of animal. Repeat within 24 hours of first treatment, if necessary. Note: This aerosol may make a slight hissing sound and cause a temporary cool sensation. Hold pet securely while applying. Nervous animals may become frightened the first time this product is used, but soon become accustomed to the treatment.
- \* To Kill Fleas and Ticks in Pet Bedding and Pet Areas: To reduce reinfestation, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding and other resting places until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray the entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary.
- \* To Treat Flea and Tick Infestation in Rugs and Carpets: Spray rugs and carpets where fleas tend to hide. If used on light or delicate upholstery fabrics, test for potential staining in an inconspicuous place prior to use. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, in walls and floors, along baseboards, window and door frame. Repeat as necessary.

3. Replacement of "Kerosene" with "Petroleum Distillate." Also, as per our telephone conversation of November 9, 1982, the words "Domestic Animals" may be deleted from the precautionary labeling.
