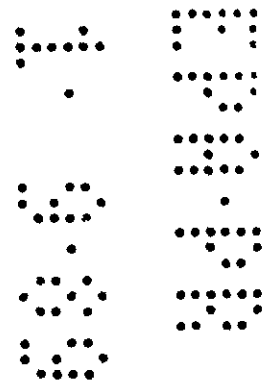

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For household use only. **SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.** Hold container upright. Point nozzle away from face and press button.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS

HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES, SMALL FLYING MOTHS AND GNATS:

Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS

ANTS AND CRICKETS: Contact as many insects as possible with spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants: treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Also treat dogs and cats with registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces, exposed food and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN, IMMEDIATELY wash with plenty of soap and water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.
