INDOOR USE:

Flying insects: To kill houseflies, small flying moths, wasps and gnats: d-CON's exclusive "ProPower" nozzle blasts more Professional Formula Flying Insect Killer to clear an average size room (10 x 12 with 8 foot ceiling) of annoying insects in minutes. Close all doors and windows and direct spray into center of room with a slow sweeping motion to fill the room with mist. Keep about 3 feet from walls, fabrics and furniture. Do not remain in treated areas. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

Crawling Insects: To kill roaches, silverfish, earwigs, fleas, ticks, spiders, waterbugs, centipedes, sowbugs, crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Spray hiding places, such as baseboards, and floor boards, moist places, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind bookcases, cabinets and other storage areas. For fleas and ticks-remove and destroy animal bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames.

Direct spray into cracks in floor. Do not spray animals. Repeat as necessary
Ants - Spray trails, hills, around window frames and openings around pipes and baseboards where ants crawl. Repeat as necessary.

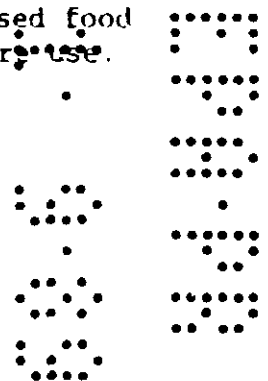
EXPOSED FORMS OF CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES AND RICE

WEEVILS: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on shelves and return package after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
