d-Con Four/Gone Automatic Room Fogger
EPA Registration No. 3282-67
Your Applications Dated January 29 and March 19, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Delete colon following "Use four/gone to DE-BUG ANY OF THESE AREAS" and add "consisting of 3000 cubic feet or greater."
2. Delete "CAMPERs, BOATS, PET SLEEPING AREAS, HOUSEHOLD STORAGE AREAS and GROUND LEVEL CRAWL SPACES"; these are not likely to contain 3000 cubic feet of space.
3. Change proposed storage instructions to read "STORAGE: Store container in area inaccessible to children."

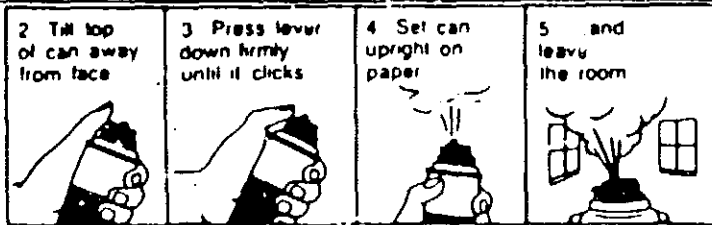
COVER asphalt tile, waxed wood floors and waxed furniture which may come in contact with the fog. (Newspapers may be used.)

OPEN cupboards, closets, trunks and interior doors in area to be treated. REMOVE pets and cover or remove fish tanks and bowls; remove or cover foods, dishes, utensils and articles made of cotton terrycloth.

CLOSE outside doors and windows; turn off fans and air conditioners; extinguish all open flames except pilot light.

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Set can on a raised spot such as a table, chair or stand at least ten feet from pilot light. Spread several sheets of paper under can to cover area directly beneath container. Remove cover.



6. Keep room being treated closed for 2 hours.
7. After 2 hours, open all doors and windows. Turn on air conditioners and fans. Let the treated area air for 30 minutes. Repeat treatment in two weeks or as necessary.

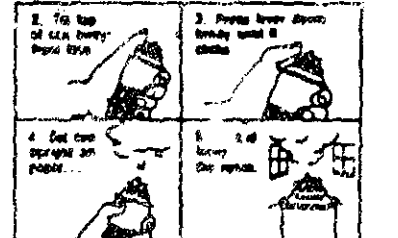
