Your Letters Dated September 11, 1985 and February 4, 1986

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

We have reviewed the efficacy data submitted with the subject letters and conclude that these test results show that the 6 ounce containers adequately control all of the pests except spiders and fleas. The percent control for spiders and fleas was much lower than that reported for the other insects tested. Therefore, you should submit additional testing for spiders and fleas and submit this information within 1 year from the date of this letter. For further reference, the EPA Accession Number assigned to the efficacy data is 259383.

In addition, at the next label printing, please revise the subheading, "If in eyes," to read, "Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately."

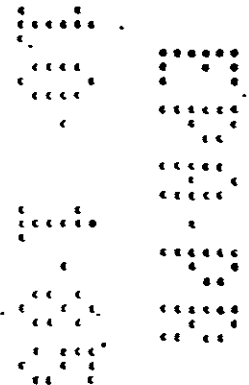
