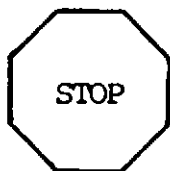

DIRECTIONS FOR HOUSEHOLD USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For effective roach killing, place all 8 (12)* bait stations at once.

1. Open pouch, remove d-STROY roach killing stations and break apart from plastic frame.
2. Place all 8 (12)* roach killing stations (with white label facing down) in areas where you have seen roaches. The triangular shape of d-STROY allows it to be placed in corners.
3. Place 4 (10)* in the kitchen and 4 (2 in the bathroom)* in other areas such as the basement or garage (see illustrations).
4. d-STROY starts working immediately, roaches eat the bait, and die (the same day)*.
5. If desired, use stickers to anchor d-STROY to surfaces. To use stickers, remove paper backing from both sides, apply to bottom of station and press to surface where you are placing station.
6. Replace all d-STROY roach killing stations every 3 months or when effectiveness diminishes for continued protection from roaches.

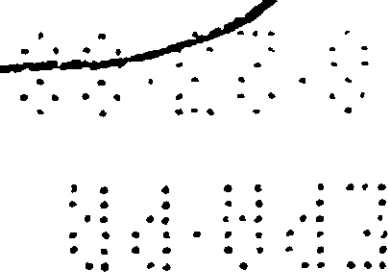

Replace all roach killing stations every three months for continued protection from roaches.

STICKER INSTRUCTIONS:

Date these stickers three months after placement date. (If placed on 6/15 replace on 9/15).

Then place these stickers on your refrigerator, inside a cabinet door, on your calendar or on top of a visible station to remind you when to replace your d-STROY Roach Killing Stations in order to maintain roach control.
